Candidate's Statement and Goals for Office:

It has been a pleasure to serve as the Grand Vice President for Collegiate Affairs for the past 4 years. I treasure the memories of working with the Regional Directors for Collegiate Affairs and greatly appreciate their advice and support. I have also learned a great deal from my experiences while working within the Executive Council under the leadership of Song You. If given the opportunity to serve the Fraternity as Grand President, I have the following goals:

- 1. I intend to lead the Executive Council through the strategic planning process to identify and prioritize common goals for communications and alumni, collegiate, and student affairs. I will endeavor to ensure our goals are mission-focused and assessment-driven. Moreover, I will strive to maintain alignment among the Executive Council towards achieving our agreed upon goals.**
- 2. I will work within the Executive Council to utilize an effective and affordable means of managing the day-to-day operations of Phi Delta Chi. I will support a system that does not distract from the leadership of the volunteers of the Fraternity, and I will support a system that does not place all of the responsibilities of the day-to-day operations on a single individual. I also believe it is the responsibility of each member of the**

Executive Council to help ensure we operate within the Fraternity's budget, manage financial resources wisely, and invest at least 2% of the total national revenue of the Fraternity in Government Bonds or approved Banks as defined within our Constitution and Bylaws.

3. I would like to see the development of a recruitment package that would be available for Collegiate Chapters to use during their Rush events and for colony coordinators to use to support the chartering of new Chapters of Phi Delta Chi.
4. I intend to work with our management company to plan further in advance for our national meetings with the goal of providing registration materials at APhA Annual Meetings.
5. Over a period of 4 years, we have seen the addition of 7 new Chapters of Phi Delta Chi, and I expect the chartering of at least 4 additional Chapters of Phi Delta Chi in the upcoming year. This represents significant growth in the number of our Collegiate Chapters. Therefore, it is time we seriously consider creating 6 regions which will increase our human resources to support our fraternal expansion.

Finally, I commit to taking our motto to heart by supporting each Grand Vice President and our Executive Director as well as calling on them for support and advice.
