Candidate's Statement and Goals for Office:

My overarching goal is to apply my experience as a faculty leader in Phi Delta Chi to improving the communication of Phi Delta Chi accomplishments, events, and aspects of brotherhood to collegiate and alumni Brothers. I have three specific goals:

1. Publish at least three issues of The Communicator each year as specified by the constitution of Phi Delta Chi.
2. Assess collegiate and alumni Brothers about the format and content of The Communicator. An assessment tool will be developed during my first year of office to determine if the current format and content of The Communicator is effective at communicating Phi Delta Chi issues to the fraternity and to determine which, if any, improvements need to be made. If this assessment indicates that alteration in format and content is needed, then changes to The Communicator would be implemented during my second year of office.
3. Assess collegiate and alumni Brothers about additional means of communications to better serve an increasingly diverse Brotherhood. The information age has provided a wide range of alternatives to the traditional print publication method of communications. To accommodate the communication needs of all Brothers, particularly those of younger generations, Phi Delta Chi may need to pursue additional means of communication beyond the print version of The Communicator. My goal is to develop an assessment tool that will determine which, if any, additional means of communications would best serve the fraternity. This assessment tool will be administered and the results analyzed during my first year of office, and, depending on the results, used to enhance our communications during my second year of office. This assessment tool would be part of the same tool as stated in my second goal above.
